Join The Read and Dream Team

The Read and Dream Team is a school-wide reading incentive program sponsored by the PTA that runs the length of the school year. Any and all reading outside of school counts toward earning a book award.

Grade level reading minute goals are as follows:

K - 420 Minutes (7hrs)	1st - 480 Minutes (8hrs)	2nd - 600 Minutes (10hrs)
3rd - 720 Minutes (12hrs)	4th - 810 Minutes (13.5hrs)	5th - 870 Minutes (14.5hrs)

Homework, pleasure reading, reading to siblings, etc. can be counted toward Read and Dream minutes. Students record the amount of time they read (or are read to) each month on their reading logs and turn them in to their teacher or to the hanging bin in the office on the due date of each month. Reading logs are available from teachers and the office.

When the grade level goal is reached, and the logs have been turned in on time, the students will receive an award. (Any minutes turned in after the due date for that month will be recorded and saved for the next month's award.) Reading logs are usually due on the last Friday of the month but some months vary due to holidays. Please refer to the schedule below for specific due dates.

The monthly award consists of a grade appropriate book of the students choosing. Each consecutive month students can earn a book by meeting their grade level reading goal. Awards for TK and Kindergarten are handed out in the classroom. Awards for grades 1-5 are handed out during lunch time, generally on their grade-level playgrounds, or in the cafeteria when raining.
